Carma Gifford welcomed everybody and turned the meeting over to Angie Chappell to review the minutes. Kip Hansen made a motion to approve the minutes, Barbara Larsen seconded it, and all other council members were in favor. Carma Gifford then turned the meeting over to Chey Lyman. They talked about about a few colleges coming for free application day. SUU on Oct 25, Snow on Oct 30, and Dixie on Nov 13. She wants to encourage all senior students to get on the website and apply to the colleges that they want to, and then come and have the admission fee waived. ACT tests will be in October and December, for any senior that wants to take it. Mrs. Lyman is working on Credit Recovery applications for the juniors, so they can get anything done and taken care of before becoming seniors.

The council watched a short video on the facts of question 1 for the upcoming votes. It stated that the money would go for things like teachers salary, extra days to prep, etc. It will NOT go to buildings, administration cost, etc. The council discussed and it was decided that if any body has a question about it, then share this video with them.

Barbara Larsen then talked about the Booster club. She said that the homecoming dinner had a lower than normal turnout this year. She made a suggestion about doing the homecoming dinner every other year, and on the off year, doing the dinner during the Richfield game. Jerolynn Bergfeld is heading up the Halloween carnival this year. She said the goal is to get the high school clubs and students to run the booths, and get the elementary kids to come and support the high school. It was asked what the money is used for, and if these were the only fundraisers for the Booster club. They do have the banner fundraiser, and homecoming dinner and Halloween carnival. Barbara Larsen told the council that the money is used for funding different clubs and sports towards the end of the year, if they apply for it. It also goes towards

two \$500 scholarships to senior students that show Ram Pride. The Booster club also helps with teacher appreciation luncheon and the senior banquet.

Mr. Beagley talked to the council about the School Improvement Plan. He went through the 4 goals that we have for our school. 1-Improve ACT scores, 2-Improve awareness of pathways, 3-Provide a safe environment, and 4-Decrease failing grades. Mr. Madsen said that safety is the biggest concern, and then pathways for all kids to get and have successes. Julie Henderson made a motion to approve the School Improvement Plan, Angela Nielsen seconded, and all other council members approved. Barbara Larsen said that she came to the awards assembly and what an awesome sight it was to see how many students earned all kinds of awards...from regular scholarships to pathways cords. There was so much representation for all aspects of education. She thought using social media and local newspapers and radios would be a great way to let the community know all the great things that SSHS is doing. Lisa Nielson mentioned that when she came in for her son's senior interview that it was awesome. How good Chey was to talk to her non-university bound student about the pathways and other options for him. She thought it was great.

Mr. Madsen talked about Trustlands Budget. \$3500 will go towards Mr. Brady for an added Biology class, and \$2400 towards Mr. Allen for Adobe software; for the CTE, and yearbook classes. Angela Nielsen made a motion to approve, Barbara Larsen seconded it, and all other council members were in favor. \$1500 towards Mrs. Hartle math class for t.v. projector, and pen. Julie Henderson made a motion to approve, Robin Hessey seconded it, and all other council members were in favor. \$1200 towards ACT teacher prep. This will have all the training and digital access for teachers to help students with the ACT test. Barbara Larsen made a motion to approve, Angela Nielsen seconded it, and all other council members were in favor. Mid semester is October 18, 2018 and this will determine eligibility for winter sports. Grades and attendance will determine eligibility.

Barbara Larsen made a motion to end the meeting, Chey Lyman seconded it, and all other council members were in favor. The next Community Council meeting will be held on Monday November 12, 2018.

These minutes have not been approved by the community council as of yet. That will take place on November 12.
