Angela Nielsen welcomed everyone and then turned the meeting over to Angie Chappell to review the minutes from the October 14 meeting. Mr. Beagley mentioned that the new scoreboard/video board will do advertising, but not replays as of yet. Kip Hansen made a motion to accept the minutes as written, with the changes on the scoreboard, Barb Larsen seconded it and all others approved.

Mrs. Lyman talked about the things that have been going on in her office. A few weeks ago, several colleges were here to register for college. 73 out of 101 seniors applied for college, and 133 applications were filled out. That was a great success! She also said that her and Mr. McCormick, part time counselor, sent out an email and 143 students replied and 80 of those students wanted a planner. They will buy planners and have a ramtime to show students how to use those planners, and will use that as a counseling project.

Mr. Beagley mentioned that the Trustlands funds for teachers to prepare grades and prep for next semester, during Christmas break, is 4 hours for each teacher, totalling \$3000, needs to be approved. Hailey Obray made a motion to accept, Dustyn Allen seconded it, and all others approved. Mr. Beagley then reviewed the TSSA funds that SSHS received. The amount received was \$16,999. Teachers were encouraged to apply for this money, and several did. Money that was requested is as follows:

which is \$6765.72 over the budget, so the council needs to reduce the amounts.

Kip Hansen suggested we take off the Redcat audios and get everything else. Lisa Nielson suggested getting the books and textbooks, and get fewer Redcat audios. Shalane Stubbs agreed with Lisa as did most of the council. Kip Hansen made a motion to accept the changes, Dustyn Allen seconded it, but not all members approved, so it was followed with a long and lively discussion that resulted in a few changes. It was suggested that books would be softcover, reduce the amount of books per class, and reduce the number of Redcat audios.

Barb Larsen talked about the Booster club money that will be available in February for clubs and organizations that make a request. To receive some of these funds, the groups should have helped the Booster club with some of their activities...Homecoming dinner, Halloween carnival etc. Barb also mentioned that the Halloween carnival was a really good success this year. There were a lot of people that came, and they ran out of every food item that they had.

Chey Lyman made a motion to adjourn, Barb Larsen seconded it, and all other members approved.
