Marsha Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes, and Kip Hansen seconded it, and all other council members approved. Carma then turned the meeting over to Chey Lyman to talk about Spring registration for Snow College concurrent enrollment, and free application days for Dixie, SUU and Snow. Several of our students took advantage of the free application. Also ACT teacher prep has been approved and details are being worked out.
