Mr. Madsen welcomed everyone to the meeting, had all members introduce themselves, and thanked them for being a part of our community council for the 2018-2019 school year. The council then watched a video of the responsibilities of the community council. We talked about the rules for order of operation, ie procedures with voting and how to conduct a meeting. Principal Madsen talked about the money our school has received and how it has been used. We then took nominations for a chair and co-chair. Carma Gifford volunteered for the chair position and Barb Larsen 2nd it. All were in favor. Hailey Obray agreed to be co-chair, and all were in favor. Mr. Madsen also informed the council that all cell phone numbers will be taken off the website, but the councils email address' will be left on.

Chey Lyman talked about senior interviews. She said that she has gone through every seniors transcript to make sure that they are on track to graduate and talks with them about what their future plans are. She has updated the scholarship page on the school website, and mentioned that college's are coming to talk to our students about college. Chey also said that the Regent's scholarship qualifications have changed so more students can take advantage of that one.

The council looked through the Trustlands budget and talked about a couple of the goals. Goal #1 budgeted \$2000 for Odysseyware that is used for credit recovery. Mr. Madsen said that it was only \$1750 and that it has already been paid. When kids need to do credit recovery there is a \$75 fee associated with each credit. If students do it in the summer, and complete the requirements, Mr. Madsen will give them a scholarship...he will pay the required fee. Goal #2 will increase our scheduling options by adding EdNet classes and Snow College options. The schedule will also add an extra Biology class for Mr. Brady, which he will need to be paid for. It will also give all teachers 4 hours of prep time during the Christmas Break. Chey Lyman made a motion to accept this and Barbara Larsen 2nd it. All others approved. Goal #3 was improving our ACT scores. This brought a lively discussion among the community council members. Some added suggestions and ways to improve ACT scores. Mr. Madsen said one good way to

improve was to increase rigor in the classroom. Our school is thinking about bringing in Strategic ACT prep to help our teachers, so that they will be able to prepare our students for the ACT test. We will discuss these in more detail and vote next month. Mr. Beagley asked the council to review the School Improvement Plan as we will be reviewing this next month also.

Barbara Larsen made a motion to end the meeting, all were in favor. Then next community council meeting will be October 8, 2018 in the media center.
