Mr. Madsen welcomed everyone and then turned the meeting over to Mr. Beagley to review the School Improvement Plan. We talked about why we have a school improvement plan, and the things that can help our school and students succeed. Things discussed were: our ACT proficiency scores, schoolwide reform strategies, including classes offered and credit recovery. There are 4 goals in the school improvement plan, which include but not limited to,

1. Improving student achievement on the ACT test by ensuring concepts on the test are taught in the classroom.
2. Improve awareness of pathways and opportunities for all students.
3. Partner with parents and community to ensure a safe and caring learning environment.
4. Decrease the number of failing grades earned by students.

Mrs. Lyman talked about things going on in the counselors office. We have a new mental health counselor, Janessa Farrer, who is here on Mondays, Thursdays, and every other Friday. Also the Paul Mccormick, SSMS counselor is here on Wednesday to help with College and Career Readiness with the freshmen. Mrs. Lyman is doing senior interviews with all seniors and parents to make sure kids are on track for graduation, and post high plans. 9th grade and 11th graders took a practice ACT test to use as a study for ACT test in February.

Mr. Madsen showed a training video of the roles and responsibilities of being on the community council. It talked about how Trustlands money should be spent, and what it can not be spent on. Everybody enjoyed it, and thought the information they learned was beneficial.

Barbara Larsen, Booster Club President, talked about the Homecoming parade and tailgate dinner that will be held on Friday, September 20th. The Halloween carnival will be on October 25. All clubs and school organizations are encouraged to come and help and have a booth. If they help there is a better chance that the club will get money from the Booster club in the spring, if they apply for it. One thought was to have a hotdog and drink fundraiser at the 3 on 3

basketball night instead of a tailgate dinner. It was discussed and everyone thought it was a good idea.

Mr. Madsen said that we need to nominate a chair and a vice chair. Hailey Obray nominated Angela Nielsen, and Julie Henderson volunteered to be vice chair. All approved.

Barbara Larsen made a motion to adjourn, Chey Lyman seconded it, and all other members were in favor.
