Counselor Corner:

All Utah College applications are free except BYU starting this year.UCAW will be at the school to help the seniors the week of October 28-30.

There is an app being developed for all the Utah schools to help with the application process for the 2025-2026 school year. **Utah launches 'Admit Utah': A simplified path to college admissions for all high school students.**

Construction update: Safety glass and doors should be in place at the entrances by January 1st. Glass will be bulletproof.
